

BLIND RESIDENT, CARING FOR

YOU SHOULD ALWAYS:

1. Identify yourself when you arrive.
2. Describe the environment.
3. Speak clearly and slowly.
4. Speak with your mouth directed toward the resident.
5. Include the resident in conversations.
6. Introduce resident to others in the conversation.
7. Tell the resident when you move an object from a familiar place.
8. Describe the location of each kind of food on a plate.
9. Place a blind resident's hand on a chair or bed before he/she sits.
10. Announce your intention to leave.
